Biebrza National Park was established in 1993 and is the largest of the Polish national parks. The most valuable habitats of the park are the famous Biebrza marshes. The wide area of 3 936 ha is under strict protection. Unique in Europe for its marshes, peatlands and its diversified fauna especially birds, is under the protection of the Ramsar Convention.
